## House Team Travel Policy

This policy applies to spring teams in the following Divisions: 9u (Tadpole); 11u (Mosquito); 13u (PeeWee) A; and 15u (Bantam) A.

From time to time spring house teams wish to play in out of town tournaments. In such a case, the following must occur:

## **Head Coach Responsibilities:**

- Inform Division Coordinator of intention to travel to an out of town tournament
- 2. Provide the Division Coordinator with the following information:
  - a. Date, location, host, and cost of Tournament
  - b. Scheduling implications, if any
  - If applicable, players requested for pick-up and acknowledgement that prior discussions and approval received from other coach and parents

## **Division Coordinator Responsibilities**

- 1. Upon Receipt for the notification, the Division Coordinator will review the information and review the following:
  - a. If the tournament is acceptable (level of play, affiliation of host, etc)
  - b. Scheduling implications and accommodations necessary
  - c. If players are being picked up, review:
    - i. Impact on other team (scheduling, pitching, etc)
    - ii. BC (Minor) Baseball Rule 6.01 (summer ball eligibility affected by playing on multiple tournament teams)
- 2. Consider impact on umpires and re-scheduling, if applicable
- 3. Make reasonable efforts to assist with rescheduling to accommodate the request.
- 4. Advise KMBA President or Vice President of the request and make recommendation with respect to approval.
