Team Fees, Fundraising, Sponsorship

This policy applies to all KMBA teams that do any of the following:

1. Collect team fees
2. Fundraise
3. Receive direct sponsorship money or gifts in kind

Should any of the above apply to a KMBA team, that team **MUST** do the following:

1. Open a team bank account (KMBA will provide the team with an authorization letter so that can be done without fees at most banks)
2. Present a team budget to the parents
3. At the conclusion of the Season present an accounting/reconciliation to the parents.

All fundraising that the team conducts in the community must be vetted in advance through the KMBA President or Vice President.

All sponsors who donate money or gifts in kind to a team must be vetted in advance by the KMBA President or Vice President.

Any sponsor donations, money or otherwise that is not paid to the team, but rather directly to a supplier does not require the team to open a bank account.

Any money that the team fails to spend at the conclusion of their season shall be directed to KMBA. Teams are encouraged to spend money left over on team items or events (wind up party or coaches gifts, etc.). Fundraising or sponsorship money left in the account and not spent by the team shall not be returned to the parents.
